FREE Mammograms for Qualifying Women

Early detection with a mammogram can reveal breast cancers so small they cannot be felt and before they have a chance to spread. At this stage, experts say a woman has the best chance of surviving the disease. Most doctors recommend that women age 40 and above (35 if there is a family history of breast cancer) have a mammogram every year.

UnityPoint Health - Marshalltown Foundation receives contributions from area donors to the Prevent Fund to help pay for mammograms at the Medical Park for qualifying women. If you have no insurance, your insurance won't pay for one, or you cannot afford the co-pay or deductible, there may be help for you.

Application deadlines: March 31 for April - July 31 for August

Women who have not had a mammogram before are the priority for these clinics. Applications are available at the main entrances of UnityPoint Health – Marshalltown: 3 South 4th Ave., the Medical Park: 55 Central Iowa Drive, local UnityPoint Health – Family Medicine clinics and online at marshalltown.unitypoint.org/foundation. **Applications must be received before the deadline for the next clinic to be considered.** Women who are accepted will be notified by phone to schedule an appointment.

Please see your doctor as soon as possible for a referral if you have symptoms that concern you.

Your mammogram at UnityPoint Health - Marshalltown will be performed by board-certified technologists who will use new 3-D mammography equipment. The Radiologists of McFarland Clinic will review the mammogram and let your doctor know the results.
